Check In Procedures Arrival & Attendance

Children go to their classroom with a parent to sign in. If this is their first time, we ask that a registration form be filled out. Once children are registered they will stay in that class for the year.

Name Tag/ Claim Tag

Each child will receive a name tag with a number on it that corresponds with the claim tag given to you, the parent.

If we need to contact you during the service, your child's number will be displayed on an electronic board on either side of the sanctuary. If you are not in the sanctuary, we will come and get you.

When you pick up your child, your claim tag must be presented at the desk before the child is allowed to leave. This system enables you to control who you want to pick up your child by giving them the tag (grandparents, siblings over 12 yrs. etc.) and it assures us that the person picking up the child is authorized to do so.
