Everyone has access to Jesus who realizes they need the touch of Jesus



His social connection and religious status gave him *no advantage*Her social alienation and "impurity" created *no barrier*



MORE.

At once Jesus realized that the power had gone from him. He turned around in the crowd and asked, "Who touched my clothes?"



His disciples said to him, "You see the crowd pressing against you and you say, "Who touched me?"



But Jesus kept looking around to see who had done it.



Then the woman, with fear and trembling, knowing what had happened to her, came and fell down before him, and told him the whole truth.



He said to her, "Daughter, your faith has healed [lit. 'saved'] you. Go in peace and be freed from your suffering."

While Jesus was still speaking, people came from the synagogue ruler's house saying, "Your daughter has died. Why trouble the teacher any longer?"



But Jesus, paying no attention to what was said, told the synagogue ruler, "Do not be afraid, just believe?"
