




bible memory



The Bible is a collection of a variety of genres of literature, written over the course of thousands of years of human history by around 40 different authors. It contains history, narrative, poetry, law, and personal letters. It is a library with 66 different books, 2 sections (called "Testaments") with one message; that God, through Jesus wants to draw us all into his life and love.

Whether you're new to faith beginning to explore the Bible, or are a long-time follower of Jesus looking to go deeper, reading the Bible is one of the best ways to grow in knowing God personally.


