

Christian Lifestyle (Article V of Bylaws)

1. This Church believes lifestyle practices should be based upon the principles of Scripture, which standard it considers to be the final authority in guiding our faith and conduct.
2. Members are expected to agree and adhere to the Affirmation of Faith.
3. Members are expected to participate actively in the life of the Church, working for its growth by contributing time, ability and money, as enabled by God.
4. Members are expected to live in accordance with the lifestyle standards of the Christian faith.
5. Accordingly, the following represent sinful lifestyle practices contrary to biblical teachings and are therefore unacceptable:
 - malicious talk and factionalism
 - lying, deceit and dishonesty
 - extramarital sexual relationships (adultery)
 - premarital sexual relationships (fornication)
 - homosexual relationships
 - abuse of alcohol, drugs and gambling
 - use of pornographic material
 - theft, fraud
 - abusive behaviour
 - sexual assault/harassment
 - practice of the occult
