Ellerslie is a church with a rich heritage and a bright future. The church leadership is aligned in its vision to make disciples who love God, love people, and serve the world, "Bringing Jesus into Life" in southwest Edmonton and beyond. Since its founding over 70 years ago, the church has grown from a small fellowship of believers to a "big steeple" church that is active in church planting and international and local cross-cultural mission, and is a leader in its denomination, the Baptist General Conference of Canada. The church conducts worship services in English and Mandarin and houses a culturally Filipino service by a sister congregation.

Over the past two years, Ellerslie has made a significant investment in its audio, video, and media infrastructure. The church has recently increased its online presence and now broadcasts two distinct worship services each week. Blessed with stable finances, Ellerslie now is planning for the next chapter in its history.

The **Technical Director: Worship Arts** (TD:WA) will support the ministry of Ellerslie Road Baptist Church by overseeing and coordinating all aspects of the Technical Arts Ministry in regard to audio, lighting, media, and video. The TD:WA's ultimate goal is to ensure that services and events across all facilities and ministries are able to utilize technology efficiently, effectively, and strategically in order to enhance the experience of those attending. While expertise in audio, lighting, media, and video is a must for this position, the emphasis is on recruiting, training, and leading a volunteer team to develop their skills.

We are searching for a candidate with formal training in production or a related discipline with broad experience with technology in a modern worship production environment. Demonstrated success in recruiting and resourcing volunteers is necessary. The successful candidate will have a growing relationship with Jesus and experience in spiritual leadership.
