"If anyone would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me. For whoever would save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will save it."

Jesus | Luke 9:23-24

Nearly anyone who accomplished something great in their life had a single-minded devotion. When you think about your favourite athlete, musician, influencer, or an expert in your field of interest, all of them were relentless in their focus to make a difference in this world. Michael Jordan is renowned for his tenacity on and off the basketball court. Steve Jobs was committed to making a dent in the universe. Nothing would stop Jesus from completing the world's greatest rescue mission, which culminated on a hill outside Jerusalem.

As Jesus rode a donkey into Jerusalem for the final time during his earthly ministry, the crowds began to rejoice and praise God for the mighty works they had seen saying, "Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!" And yet, drawing near to the city, Jesus started to weep. He wept for the people, for they didn't know what was to come and he cried for himself, knowing how it was all going to end.

Over the past two winters we've been watching Jesus' journey throughout the book of Luke. In 2022 we saw Jesus enter the scene as a **Game Changer**. In 2023 we walked with Jesus on his **Journey to Jerusalem**. This year our story will conclude with the **Journey to the Cross**. Over the next three months we'll look closely at Jesus' life and learn from the man who is God - watching his actions and listening to his words with eyes set on the cross before him.

In observing the life of Jesus, we are reminded this isn't just a fascinating story, but as the verse at the top of the page says, we must acknowledge we are also on a journey to the cross in which losing our lives for God is the only way to find life and experience its fullness.

learn + serve

At Ellerslie, we believe discipleship happens best when we learn and serve together. Adult participants are encouraged to serve 1-2 nights during the 12 week period. **To learn about the various serving opportunities visit erbc.ca/register.**

early childhood programs

Kids programming is available for parents who are on-site only (excluding KIDLead). At least one parent needs to be on-site either serving or attending an adult program.

ages 1 - 3 | play + praise

A fun and safe place for little ones while their parents serve or attend a class.

ages 4 - grade 1 | wee college

A tried and tested discipleship program, designed for developing strong Bible-based believers during the formational years of a child's life. The course builds on itself each week meaning regular attendance is important.

elementary programs

grades 2 - 6 | ekids club

Kids will enjoy hands-on learning experiences using prayer journals, high-energy games, crafts, and a service project all while focusing on character building through Biblical truths.

grades 4 - 6 | KIDLead

A mentorship program designed to develop servant leaders. KIDLead is already in progress from September 2023. It will be closed to new members until September 2024.

youth programs

grades 7 - 9 | jr. youth

Junior High students will enjoy games and weekly lessons that challenge their faith and develop a healthy sense of community.

grades 10 - 12 | sr. youth

Senior High students will take part in a Bible study that guides them in how to read scripture and apply it to their lives. It is designed to support their transition into young adulthood.

adult programs

Adult programming will run in two 6-week terms. Courses will repeat each term so participants are able to engage in two different studies during the 12 week period.

The Bible Course

Whether you're new to the Bible or a seasoned scholar, this course will give you an overview of different genres of scripture and how each book fits into the overarching story God is telling through his Word.

The Marriage Course

The creators of Alpha designed this course for couples looking for practical support to strengthen their marriage. Together you'll learn how to build a strong foundation, communicate more effectively, and resolve differences well.

The Problem of God

An engaging mix of theology, philosophy, science, and story to investigate the essential questions that weigh on the human mind such as God's existence, evil and suffering, etc.

Alpha (second term only)

Explore the basics of the Christian Faith. This course engages people from all walks of life in conversations about life's big questions. You can take Alpha to grow personally or invite someone to join you in a conversation about faith.


