Psalms | The Prayer Book of Jesus and the Exiles

When you think of today's world leaders, what image comes to mind? Maybe it's a President making significant decisions, a CEO giving a public address, or a King enjoying some luxurious vacation. What probably doesn't come to mind is a Prime Minister crafting a poem or a Military Leader writing a song on the battlefield, yet that's exactly what we encounter when we open the book of Psalms.

Throughout the history of Israel, their leaders would write songs, poems, and prayers to remind them of significant events. When God miraculously brought Israel out of Egypt, the response of the Israelites was to sing (Exodus 15). When David learned the son he had through adultery had died, he confessed his sin (Psalm 51), and when a prophet saw violence wherever he turned, he cried out in prayer (Habakkuk 1). Over the centuries, the Jewish people would collect the best of these works and sing them at home and the synagogue.

Then disaster struck.

After years of God warning his people to repent of their sins and turn towards him, his patience came to an end. The Babylonians conquered Jerusalem, destroyed the Temple, and enslaved the defeated to exile. It was in captivity that some Jewish leaders gathered together their favourite Psalms (150 in total) and crafted a book of prayer that would be used by exiles and Jesus alike.

The book of Psalms is divinely inspired, covering the entire spectrum of human emotion. While many of the prayers could be broadly categorized as praise or lament, they are also so much more nuanced than that. We read about anger, frustration, vengeance, and confession, while also engaging with joy, thanksgiving, forgiveness, and the coming Messiah. Even within the larger book of Psalms, we see five smaller books giving us broad strokes of the story of David's royal family, the exile of Israel, and the promise of a future temple and king, closing with five powerful songs of praise.

Over the next eight weeks, we will embrace these emotions, understanding both the power of lament and praise and being reminded that much like Jesus and the Israelites before him, we too are exiles, awaiting the fullness of God's kingdom.
