

"Abram believed the Lord, and he counted it to him as righteousness."

Genesis 15:6

In our lives, it can be challenging to follow God's will - obedience is often harder than we'd like to admit. Sometimes we lack clarity on the direction God wants us to go. Other times, even when we know God's plan, it may seem too difficult to follow, and we might feel that our own plans are better, easier, and more fun.

In the book of Genesis, a significant shift occurs between chapters 11 and 12. The first eleven chapters are a theological history that describe the creation of the world, the beginning of humanity, and the introduction of sin into the world resulting in our need for a Saviour. We read how God hits the "reset" button by flooding the earth, only to have humanity return to our evil ways and our default setting of wanting to becoming like God. So, God shift gears.

Instead of leaving humanity to its own devices, God selects one man, Abram, to be the father of the nation of Israel. In Genesis 12:2-3, God says to Abram, "I will make you a great nation and I will bless you; I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you, and whoever curses you I will curse, and all the peoples on earth will be bless through you."

Thankfully, Abram chose to follow God's will for his life, and his obedience was credited to him as righteousness. However, it was not an easy path. Abram faced questions about his heir, had significant challenges to overcome, and experienced moments when God seemed silent - challenges that many of us also encounter.

This series focuses on how to remain faithful in our obedience, even when it seems difficult. This is the story of Abraham.


