There are serious health consequences to ignoring our physical health over the long term.

Our souls need as much care as our bodies. When we neglect them, they become unhealthy, and we suffer the effects. We sin and have to carry it like heavy baggage, we're made to feel unworthy by someone's words or actions, and we often experience the pain of loss or failure. All of these things weigh us down, and our souls pay the price.

If we want to live the fulfilling life that Jesus died to provide for us, filled with love, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control, as well as authentic deep-rooted joy, we have to prioritize caring for our souls.



Meet Mike

I was raised in a blended family with six siblings, including myself, and came to faith when I was 6 years old. During my student years, I discovered a strong desire to follow God and encountered Him in ways that set the trajectory for my life. I had a passion for sports and music, however, my plans to pursue a soccer scholarship changed when I felt God leading me to music.



In my early teenage years, I started taking music lessons for drums, guitar, bass, voice, and piano and began leading worship at the age of 15. I was actively involved at my home church, City Life in Chilliwack BC, for about 20 years where I led worship, played as a musician, and was part of teams that frequently travelled for missions and worship ministry.

I began my studies at Portland Bible College in 2009 and received my Bachelor's degree as a Worship Pastor while continuing to grow my skills as a musician and vocalist. I also worked as a High School Worship Teacher at City Christian School. During this period, I felt a reaffirmation of my calling to ministry and worship. I wrote and recorded 12 songs, one of which won a Christian songwriting contest that was featured on Christian radio.

In 2014, I returned home to Chilliwack to help with a church plant in Vancouver, BC where I took on the role of the Worship Director. In pursuit of deepening my relationship with God, I relocated to California in 2017, where I attended Bethel Church. During my time there, I enrolled in their ministry school, which provided me with the opportunity to travel around the world on ministry trips. In 2020, I was ordained as a Pastor and offered a staff position at the church's ministry school. Additionally, I interned in their audio/visual production department and was a regular member of their worship teams.

In December 2023, I returned home to BC to await God's direction. This past summer, He opened a door through which I was introduced to Ellerslie. I couldn't have imagined where God's plans would take my life and I'm thankful for this new season. I feel blessed to call Ellerslie home alongside all of you!
