At Ellerslie, we believe discipleship happens best when we learn and serve together! Adult participants are encouraged to serve 1-2 nights during the 8 week period. View the available roles below and choose what area(s) you'd like to serve in during online registration.

Set-Up Team | Arrive at 4:30 pm to set up tables and chairs in the Gym.

Kitchen Prep | Arrive at 4:00 pm (time varies each week) to help prepare dinner for the evening, under the direction of the Kitchen Leader.

Kitchen Clean-Up | Arrive at 6:45 pm to wash and put away dishes from dinner and ensure the kitchen is left tidy.

Kids Team | Arrive at 6:45 pm to help in one of the Kids Programs as a Classroom Assistant, supporting the Leader in caring for children and assisting with activities. (A Vulnerable Sectors Check will be required.)

Youth Team | Arrive at 6:45 pm to assist in the Youth Program as a Discussion Facilitator, engaging teens in conversation. (A Vulnerable Sectors Check will be required.)

Please register online in advance at <u>erbc.ca/register</u>. Log into Church Centre using your mobile number. A one-time security code will be sent to your mobile for verification purposes.

- 1. Select the number of people attending each program.
- 2. Select which person will be attending each program.
- 3. For adults, select the program you plan to attend and the area(s) you would like to serve in.
- **4. If you selected KIDLead option** for your child(ren), you will be asked to confirm they have been formally accepted into the program. (Applying does not guarantee acceptance).
- **5.** Review your selections to be sure they're correct.
- **6.** You're finished! Keep an eye out for an e-mail confirmation.

kids + youth programs

Kids programming is available for parents who are on-site only (excluding KIDLead). At least one parent needs to be on-site either serving or attending an adult program.

ages 1 - 3 | play + praise

A fun and safe place for little ones while their parents serve or attend a class.

ages 4 - kinder | ekids club junior

Young children will explore the Armour of God through interactive activities, including stories, crafts, and games.

grades 1 - 6 | ekids club

Students will have fun with hands-on learning experiences, games, and crafts all while discovering the Armour of God!

grades 4 - 6 | KIDLead

A mentorship program designed to develop servant leaders. To attend KIDLead, students must have applied in advance and received formal acceptance.

grades 7 - 12

Students will enjoy games and weekly lessons that challenge their faith while developing a sense of community.
