from the pastor

Throughout my entire adult life, I have been fascinated by understanding the context of a situation. When studying history, I often wonder what led to disagreements or wars – what circumstances caused tempers to boil over? While watching a fun superhero movie, I wonder about the origin story that enabled the character to gain their powers. I love the NFL and enjoy watching the games, but I'm also interested in the storylines and broader picture as we approach the playoffs. The Scriptures are no different and require an understanding of context.

You don't need to attend Ellerslie for very long to notice my sermons regularly include the context of the situation. For example, during *Simply Christmas* I spoke on Isaiah's prophecy about the birth of Jesus and how it didn't occur in a vacuum - it took place against the backdrop of exile and captivity for the Israelites. In both of our fall sermon series' we explored several significant topics, including money, speech, identity, and forgiveness. The overarching context for all these sermons is the healing of our hearts.

As we begin the new year and explore the opening chapters of the book of Acts, we get to go behind the scenes and see how the church was established. For three years, the disciples followed Jesus, relying on him as a safety net. But as he ascends into heaven, what are his followers supposed to do next? How do they teach? How do they live in community? How do they differentiate themselves from their Jewish brothers and sisters? How do they engage with Gentiles (anyone who isn't a Jew)?

In the coming weeks, we will witness the extraordinary power of the Holy Spirit, the boldness of Peter and John, and remarkable miracles. We will read dynamic speeches and listen to challenging conversations. Through these sermons, we will be invited to discover the rich context of Acts and how the early church began.
