Those who live according to the sinful nature have their minds sets on what that nature desires; but those who live in accordance with the spirit have their minds set on what the spirit desires. The mind of the sinful man is death, but the mind controlled by the spirit is life and peace.

from the pastor

For as long as I can remember, I have been taught that spending time with God is a duty. I want to clarify that this instruction hasn't come across as harsh or authoritarian; for the most part, people have been loving and encouraging. However, as teachings about reading the Bible, praying, and lesser-known practices like fasting, solitude, and journaling have continued, this concept can sometimes feel more burdensome than joyful. Even the terminology we use—calling these activities disciplines, practices, and devotions—makes me wonder if we have done ourselves a disservice.

On a personal level, I'm an introvert and a fairly disciplined individual. I recharge my batteries when I'm alone, and I thrive on having a regular routine and structure. However, have we unintentionally sidelined our extroverted friends by focusing so much on the importance of solitude in our spiritual practices? If these spiritual rhythms are designed to draw us closer to God, how can we approach them from a different perspective than what we may have heard in the past? How can we experience the joy, freedom, and closeness we often hear about, but may struggle to find on our own?

In this series on *Spiritual Rhythms*, we want to accomplish three main objectives. First, teaching you five different rhythms to help you grow closer to God, which is what you would expect in a series like this. The next two goals may be more unique. Second, speaking to both introverts and extroverts, exploring how this experience can resonate with individuals based on how each of us are wired. Finally, we will discuss the significance of these spiritual rhythms in the Christian life and their impact on our souls.

Spiritual rhythms serve as a form of spiritual warfare, rather than just another task on a Christian to-do list. By reading Scripture, we affirm God's truth and dispel the lies of the enemy. Taking a day of Sabbath rest reminds us that God is in control, not our schedules. Living in community helps us combat spiritual isolation. These are some of the spiritual rhythms that God invites us to embrace in order to experience a fuller life.
