

Welcome Home


More than a building.


Sunday Services

This decision addressed practical needs - balancing growing attendance between services, particularly in Children's Ministry, and easing strain on our Technical Team. It also supported our desire to foster unity and connect with new believers and seekers more effectively.

The change quickly brought positive results, especially in Children's Ministry, where attendance is now evenly distributed in both services, supporting our goal of growing a strong ministry for young families.

With the hiring of **Mike Barton** as the Worship Director, we've introduced a style that blends hymns, throwback songs, and contemporary music, helping all generations meaningfully engage in worship. Mike has also improved sound quality, with more enhancements to come both online and in person. We continue to see new families each week and trust God to deepen our community and draw more people to Himself!



Ellerslie Kids

Highlights

At Ellerslie Kids, our mission is to partner with parents to help every child know God personally, love Him passionately, and follow Him purposefully. We are committed to creating a Christ-centred environment where relationships, safety, engaging lessons, and - above all - Jesus are at the heart of everything we do.

This year has been full of exciting milestones and meaningful moments! On Sunday, May 11th, we celebrated a big achievement by surpassing our Sunday attendance goal with **257 kids** in ekids church - up from a strong spring average of 220 each week.

Summer was another highlight, with our *Scuba Summer Day Camp* becoming our largest yet, welcoming **237 kids** and supported by an incredible serve team of **120 individuals**!

We're also thrilled to see spiritual growth happening at home. Over **70 elementary students** completed Bible Reading Plans this year, with many parents sharing how these resources have helped them engage more consistently in God's Word with their children.

We are so thankful for what God is doing in and through Ellerslie Kids, and we look forward to seeing even more families grow in faith together in the year ahead!



Ellerslie Youth

Highlights

This year, **2 students** made the powerful decision to be baptized at Friday Night Youth. It was incredible to witness them boldly share how God has transformed their lives and how their love for Christ has grown since that step of faith.

The Christian Student Association (CSA) continued to thrive this year at both Lillian Osborne and Dr. Anne Anderson High Schools, reaching over **100 students** each week with the life-changing message of Jesus.

In May, **50 students** took part in our Youth Retreat at Lone Prairie Camp that focused on building community and digging deep into God's Word. Centred on the theme "In It to Win It: Living My Life with Purpose," the retreat inspired students to pursue a life rooted in intentional faith. Thanks to the generosity of our church community, **over \$4,000** was raised to support student sponsorships and help keep the retreat accessible for all!

We were incredibly thankful to have **Jenine Schatz** serve as our Youth Intern this past year, alongside **Brianna Friesen** as our Youth Assistant. This dynamic duo played a vital role in leading the youth component of Family Discipleship Night and expertly managing the details of Friday nights and the Youth Retreat. Their energy, leadership, and heart for students have made a lasting impact!

Ellerslie Women

Our Women's Ministry saw exciting growth this year, hosting seven events - more than double the previous year - centred on discipleship and community! We also embraced opportunities to serve, creating Christmas baskets for families in need and supporting our mission partner, Adeara Recovery Centre.

Small Groups + Triads

We're committed to helping you grow in faith and connect in meaningful community. Our small groups - typically 6–12 people - vary in size, focus, and life stage, offering a space for connection and spiritual growth. For deeper study and authentic sharing, triads bring together 3–5 individuals of the same gender to journey closely in faith together.

Kare Kits

This ministry, led by Ellerslie and Grace Point Church, serves individuals experiencing homelessness in downtown Edmonton. Through monthly outreach and the provision of practical supplies, our team builds meaningful relationships and shares the love of Jesus in tangible ways. Each month 80 to 200 Kare Kits are distributed!

This year, we introduced a new format with group teaching followed by small group discussion and prayer. Each term included a service project - packing 25 shoeboxes for Operation Christmas Child in the fall and preparing Kare Kits in the winter. Average Attendance each Term


Family Discipleship Night

The heart of this ministry is to encourage personal growth in discipleship while building meaningful connections over a delicious shared meal! Throughout the fall and winter terms, we offered seven adult classes - each uniquely focused on topics like raising Christ-centred families, living out our faith in practical ways, navigating grief, and exploring faith through Alpha.

Following our **Soul Care** sermon series, a follow-up class during Family Discipleship Night invited participants to dig deeper into the "dirty laundry" of the heart - creating space for God to bring healing and transformation. These sessions led to powerful moments of pastoral counselling, where our team witnessed the Holy Spirit move through prayer - bringing freedom, restoration, and a deeper experience of God's love!

Starlight

Highlights

Beginning in January 2025, our Mandarin-language congregation aligned its teaching with the sermon series of our English congregation. This was an intentional step toward growing together as one unified church family!

Every Saturday, Starlight host *Saturday Fellowship*, a churchwide gathering where people of all ages engage in Bible reading, study, and prayer. This year, eight classes were offered, covering topics like parenting, marriage, and a special study for seniors. At the same time, an average of **60 children** participated in Chinese language classes. We also ran three Alpha courses - one in the fall for new immigrants, a mini-session from January to April, and a current session for youth from immigrant families.

Recognizing a growing number of new immigrant families with teens, Starlight partnered with Youth Alpha to launch a bilingual Alpha course tailored for Mandarin-speaking youth. This initiative is helping to bridge the language gap and build stronger relationships between Starlight and Ellerslie Youth, creating a smoother integration for these teens.

Alpha has been a powerful tool in Starlight's ministry, leading many to faith in Jesus. A standout moment this year was when Charlene Dong, Starlight's Director, received a fully sponsored invitation to the **Global Chinese Alpha Conference** in Kuala Lumpur. This event equipped her with new tools and strategies for evangelism and fostered meaningful partnerships with Chinese Christian leaders from around the world!
