#### learn + serve

At Ellerslie, we believe discipleship happens best when we learn and serve together! Adult participants are encouraged to serve 1-2 nights during the 8 week period. View the available roles below and choose what area(s) you'd like to serve in during online registration.

**Set-Up Team** | Arrive at 4:30 pm to set up tables and chairs in the Gym.

**Kitchen Prep** | Arrive at 4:00 pm (time varies each week) to help prepare dinner for the evening, under the direction of the Kitchen Leader.

**Kitchen Clean-Up** | Arrive at 6:45 pm to wash and put away dishes from dinner and ensure the kitchen is left tidy.

**Kids Team** | Arrive at 6:40 pm to help in one of the Kids Programs as a Classroom Assistant, supporting the Leader in caring for children and assisting with activities. (A Vulnerable Sectors Check will be required.)

**Youth Team** | Arrive at 6:45 pm to assist in the Youth Program as a Discussion Facilitator, engaging teens in conversation. (A Vulnerable Sectors Check will be required.)

# registration

**Please register online in advance at <u>erbc.ca/register</u>.** Log into Church Centre using your mobile number. A one-time security code will be sent to your mobile for verification purposes.

- 1. Select the number of people attending each program.
- 2. Select which person will be attending each program.
- 3. For adults, select the program you plan to attend and the area(s) you would like to serve in.
- **4. If you selected KIDLead option** for your child(ren), you will be asked to confirm they have been formally accepted into the program. (Applying does not guarantee acceptance).
- **5.** Review your selections to be sure they're correct.
- **6.** You're finished! Keep an eye out for an e-mail confirmation.

# kids + youth programs

Kids programming is available for parents who are on-site only (excluding KIDLead). At least one parent needs to be on-site either serving or attending an adult program.

## ages 1 - 3 | play + praise

A fun and safe place for little ones while their parents serve or attend a class.

#### ages 4 - kinder | ekids club junior

Young children will learn how to experience God through prayer with interactive activities, including stories, crafts, and games.

### grades 1 - 6 | ekids club

Students will have fun with hands-on learning experiences, games, and crafts all while discovering the power of prayer.

## grades 4 - 6 | KIDLead

A mentorship program designed to develop servant leaders. To attend KIDLead, students must have applied in advance and received formal acceptance.

### grades 7 - 12

Students will enjoy games and weekly lessons that challenge their faith while developing a sense of community.

## **Experiencing God**

#### Cashflo

Cashflo is a Bible-centred study on inviting God's wisdom into our personal finances. We'll explore practical ways to steward resources with confidence, create spending plans, set meaningful goals, and build strategies that reflect both faith and intentionality.

#### Griefwalk

Loss can feel like it separates us from God when we need Him most. Griefwalk provides a safe place to share, find hope, and receive compassion on the journey through grief. If you've lost a loved one, come join us as we walk together toward healing.

#### Exile and Return | Men

Men, join us on a journey through the Old Testament as we explore how God's people built His kingdom in a foreign land. Their story is our story - we too are strangers in a broken world, called to build for His glory. Exile and Return challenges us to ask: Am I building my life for Christ?

#### Freedom Session | Women

Ladies, join us on a powerful discipleship journey where Jesus brings healing, freedom, and purpose. Through biblical teaching, small group discussion, and personal reflection, you'll discover how to rewrite your story with a God-inspired ending.

This course runs in two semesters, meeting at 6:00 pm (earlier than Family Discipleship Night). Each semester is 10 weeks long - one in the fall and one in the winter - and extends beyond the regular Family Discipleship Night schedule. **If you require childcare please contact freedomsession@erbc.ca.**
