Thoughts from a board member

The ERBC church board is a governance board which provides oversight in many areas such as mission, finances, legal compliance and vision/values. As we seek to not only ensure that the lead pastor's ministry is supported but to understand where God is leading us as a church, there is a strong emphasis placed on prayer.

The board meets once per month. Before every second meeting supper is provided; this is an informal way for members to get to know one another on a more personal level. As agenda items are discussed, member's views are encouraged and heard. The Lead Pastor Dave Schmidt and Executive Director of Operations, Russ McDermott share with us and give us a behind-the-scenes report on what they are currently involved with. At most meetings an inperson report is provided by one of the ministry leaders, allowing us to hear from them and to learn what is happening within their respective programs. These are highlights for me. Of course there are also the other agenda items, which are often more routine.

Serving as a board member is the result of feeling a strong conviction that God needed me to become involved in ERBC in a way I had not served previously. As I prayerfully considered this, I wasn't sure how or in what capacity - until I was asked by the discernment committee to consider a board position. I truly did not feel that as a retired RN, I had the skill set required. I took the leap though and have found the experience to be positive and life changing. I have been reminded that strong churches need strong leadership and a cohesive board. This is especially true in today's world where there is a tendency to distort the truth. I have grown in my faith and prayer life and have been blessed to get to know many people both on and off the board who possess strong leadership skills, as well as a solid and genuine faith in God.

If you are approached to serve as a board member, I would encourage you to prayerfully give it some thought, even if you do not feel that you are right for the job. You never know where it can lead you! It takes many different people to build His kingdom.




