At Ellerslie, we believe discipleship happens best when we learn and serve together! Adult participants are encouraged to serve 1-2 nights during the 8 week period. View the available roles below and choose what area(s) you'd like to serve in during online registration.

Set-Up Team | Arrive at 4:30 pm to set up tables and chairs in the Gym and classrooms.

Kitchen Prep | Arrive at 4:00 pm (time varies each week) to help prepare dinner for the evening, under the direction of the Kitchen Leader.

Kitchen Clean-Up | Arrive between 6:30-6:45pm to wash and put away dishes from dinner and ensure the kitchen is left tidy.

kids + youth programs

ages 1 - 3 | play + praise

A fun and safe place for little ones while their parents serve or attend a class.

ages 4 - grade 1 | ekids club junior

Young children will learn how to experience God through prayer with interactive activities, including stories, crafts, and games.

grades 2 - 4 | ekids club

Students will have fun with hands-on learning experiences, games, and crafts all while discovering the power of prayer.

grades 5 - 6 | Crew 56

Students will play games, do prayer stations, spend time learning from the Bible, and have gym time.

grades 5 - 6 | KIDLead

A mentorship program designed to develop servant leaders. To attend KIDLead, students must have applied in advance and received formal acceptance. Deadline to apply is Sept. 20, 2026.
